



Jerry Discher

October 30, 1946 - March 7, 2013

The funeral service for Gerald "Jerry" Douglas Discher will be held at 2:00p.m. on Tuesday, March 12, 2013 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Pastor Melissa Ehrhardt officiating. Friends may call at the church on Monday from 4:00-8:00 p.m. and again on Tuesday from 12:30 p.m. until the time of service. Surrounded by his family, Jerry passed away at the age of 66, on Thursday, March 7, 2013 at his home in Eagle Bend, MN.

Jerry was born on October 30, 1946 to Alfred and Lorraine (Wall) Discher at Mountain Lake, MN. He served his country in the US Army from 1964—1968.

Jerry was married to Paula Dearchs on November 1, 1969. They have four children: Todd (Wendie) Discher of Danube, Marcia (Michael) Sidime of St. Cloud, Joshua (Stephanie) Discher of Eagle Bend and Jeremy (Mindy) Discher also of Eagle Bend; twelve grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Jerry was a farmer, carpenter, salesman and bait dealer. He enjoyed hunting with his dog Goldie, fishing, trapping and catching pigeons. He also ran a game farm and was known to many as "pigeon man". He was a member of the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend.

Jerry was preceded in death by his parents Alfred and Lorraine; uncle Doug Wall; aunt Bea Warner; and grandson Dillion Lancaster.

He is survived by his loving wife Paula; his children, grandchildren and great-grandchild; and sister Dianne (Ron) Stroup of Mason City, Iowa.
