October 17, 1985 - February 5, 2017

The Celebration of Life Open House for Jessica Lannes, of Wadena, will be held on Friday, February 10, from 1:00 until 4:00 p.m. with a Time of Prayer and Sharing led by Pastor Jim Stoneman at 2:30 p.m. at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena. At age 31, Jessica died due to an automobile accident on Sunday, February 5, 2017, near Wadena, MN.

Jessica was born to Donnie and Caryl (Frisbee) Lannes on October 17, 1985 in Wadena, MN. She was active in school, graduating from Wadena-Deer Creek High School and then remained in the area. She was a stay-at-home mom who devoted her life to her son, Mason. Favorite things to do were taking selfies of the two of them and communicating with friends on Facebook. Jess really enjoyed time spent with friends and family.

Jessica was preceded in death by her birth mother Caryl Frisbie-Johnson and grandmother Arlene Lund.

She is survived by her son Mason Mousseau; fiancé' Jamie Mousseau of Wadena; father Donnie Lannes of Deer Creek; brothers Cody (fiancée Tabitha) Hamann, Preston Butler and Tyler Frisbie; sisters Amanda (Kipp) Greenwaldt and Brittany Frisbie; grandparents Robert Lund, Bill and Linda Johnson, and Judy Frisbie; along with numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.
