April 30, 1924 - July 11, 2003

James Aloysious Wynn was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota on April 30, 1924 to George and Laura Wynn. James entered the Navy as an apprentice seaman on September 24th, 1942 to serve his country in World War II but for medical reasons was honorably discharged early on December 4, 1944 and he returned to OtterTail County, Minnesota. On October 15, 1951, James joined in marriage with Arlene K. Tellers at St. John's Catholic Church in Bluffton, Minnesota. He lived in Wadena, Minnesota area for 52 years and was active in his community with the Wadena Elks Club and American Legion and in his church with his activities with Catholic Aid. He enjoyed bowling, pitching horseshoes, fishing and dancing. What he enjoyed most, though, was spending time with his family. James passed away on July 11, 2003 at the Tri-County Hospital in Wadena at the age of 79 years. James was preceded in death by his parents George Wynn and Andrew and Laura (Wynn) Wehmanen.
