The Celebration of Life memorial service for John Manselle of Deer Creek, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 2, at the Salem United Methodist Church in Deer Creek, with Pastor Lee Kantonen presiding. Visitation will be held on Monday from 4:00 until 7:00 p.m. at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena, and will resume at the church on Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of service. Tragically, John died at the Tri-County Healthcare Hospital in Wadena, after icy conditions caused his car accident on Wednesday, April 26, 2017, near New York Mills, MN. He was 50 years old.

On January 4, 1967, in Wadena, MN, Terry and Judy (Matthiesen) Manselle were blessed with a baby boy they named John Lloyd Manselle. He was a true gift from God and lived a full life while he was here.

On December 6, 2015, John met his soul-mate. He married Robbin Darlene Oliphant on May 12, 2016. John told her he would always be with her and he was until his dying day. It was a short time together, but in that time John learned how it was to be truly loved. John loved to fish and hunt, and do anything outdoors.

On April 26, 2017, John was taken from this earth way too soon. He left behind his wife Robbin Manselle of Deer Creek; a step-daughter Jessica Moore and grandson Amauri Gentry of Carthage, MS; step-son Jamie Moore

of California; brothers Kurt (Mira) Manselle of Deer Creek and Troy (Cyndie) Manselle of Wyoming; along with six nieces and nephews.

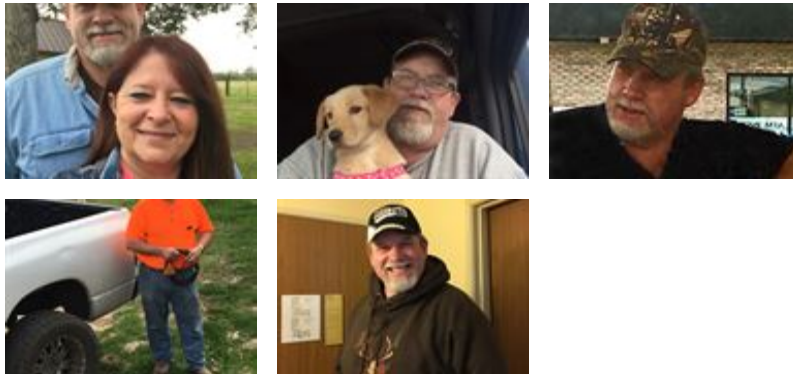
