The funeral service for Jozi Szathmary, of Minneapolis and formerly of Wadena, will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, April 1, 2015 at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena. Friends may call on Tuesday from 5:00 until 8:00 PM at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena with a rosary service at 6:00 PM and parish prayers at 7:00 PM. Visitation will continue at the church on Wednesday from 12:30 PM until the time of service. At the age of 37, Jozi received her angel wings on March 28, 2015.

Jozi, aka Jozsef , worked as a barista in Minneapolis for 8 years and also had a passion for the performing arts. She loved music, singing, stand-up comedy, and caring for animals. She was a very kind kindred spirit, who touched everyone and everything with love. Her heart was the size of a mountain and as strong as an oak tree. She was compassionate, strong willed, and extremely loving; always wearing her heart on her sleeve. Jozi was also a huge part of the LGBT family, which helped her find herself. Her best times were spent with family & friends.

She was preceded in death by her grandparents; a nephew; uncles and cousins.

Jozi is survived by her parents, Laszlo and Gail Szathmary of Wadena; brothers Laszlo Szathmary Jr of Crosby, Kenneth Szathmary of Motley, David
