Beyond her professional accomplishments, she was also an author, an

She found beauty in life's quieter moments as well. She loved daisies, the comforting scent of ginger, peaceful walks, kayaking, bicycling, and time spent outdoors. She appreciated solitude and reflection yet gave so much of herself to those she loved. Her hands were rarely still - she lovingly crocheted countless blankets for family and friends and had recently begun learning the art of quilting.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Leonard and Marguerite Lindberg; brother Charles; sister, Janice; sister-in-law, Edith Lindberg; brothers-in-law, John Murray and Larry Gaskins; and niece, Dianne Lindberg.

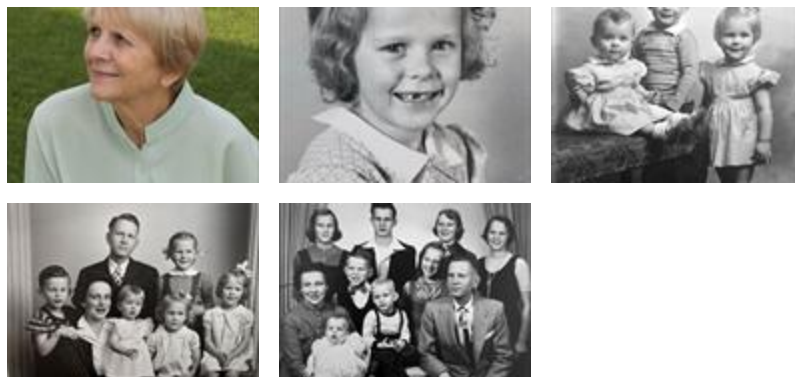
