The Mass of Christian Burial for June Stafki will be celebrated at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, November 16, at the St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Bluffton, with Father Aaron Kuhn as celebrant. Visitation will be held on Sunday, from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena with Rosary at 5:00 and Prayers at 6:00 p.m. Visitation will resume at the church on Monday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of Mass. June Jeanette Stafki of New York Mills, formerly of Deer Creek, passed away peacefully to glory, November 12, 2015, at the Golden Living Center in Henning, MN.

June Jeanette Gackstetter was born May 30, 1935, to Elmer & Laura (Truhler) Gackstetter of Inver Grove Heights, MN. She had one older sister Ethel, who was also her best friend. Growing up on the family farm was a grand adventure for her and she enjoyed working with their team of horses in the field alongside her father, and getting to drive the Model T to the market at age nine. June was an outstanding student as well, and graduated near the top of her class of several hundred students, from South Saint Paul High School in 1953. She worked at Swift Inc. for a short time and in lieu of accepting a full scholarship, chose to become a wife and mother fulltime. June married Paul E. Stafki on Dec 31, 1955. They made their home in and around the Twin Cities finally settling in Hugo, where Paul built a home for them.

Their marriage was blessed with nine children. In 1975, they sold their home

and moved to a farm near Deer Creek MN. While Paul continued to commute to the Twin Cities for masonry work, June managed the farm with the help of the children. June stayed on the farm until 2001 when she moved to New York Mills. After Paul's death in 1994, June went to work as a Certified Nursing Assistant at the Elders Home in New York Mills. She retired in 2001 and began what would be a 10 year relationship of love as a foster grandparent. "Grandma June", was a role she dearly loved, at the Heart of the Lakes Elementary School in Perham. She was forced to retire from that position, after a serious stroke in 2012. June continued to reside in New York Mills at her much beloved Home Sweet Home assisted living center, in spite of her declining health. September of 2015 she moved to the Golden Living Center of Henning.

June's hobbies included: reading, watching birds, playing accordion, listening to sporting events on the radio or listening to music of all varieties and years of dancing with her favorite dance partner, husband Paul. They were well known on the dance floor for their smooth style and grace and even featured in the Ironworld Polka Museum Hall of Fame. June loved all of her years on the farm, naming her many cattle, sheep and turkeys and spent hours with her "pets". She also raised a massive flower, fruit and vegetable garden every season storing up its bounty each fall. But, most especially, she loved being a mother and grandmother. She spent hours reading to her children and playing and teaching them games (she was a fierce Yahtzee opponent), sewing their clothes, and teaching them to garden, farm and care for the animals, how to dance, pray and of course, all about Jesus. June was a fantastic prayer warrior, too. June taught religious education for many years at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Bluffton MN. Some of her happiest times were the many hours of reading to the children, listening to their stories and sharing hugs with all of the children she encountered in her 10 years as Grandma June at Heart of the Lakes. To her delight and surprise she received The President's Volunteer Service Award, the Perham Area Outstanding Citizen

Award and was even nominated one of six finalist for the Catholic Charities USA 2006 National Volunteer Award.

June was a member of or volunteered for: The Wadena Concert Association, Tri County Hospital Hospice, St. John the Baptist Catholic Church Christian Mothers, Wadena VFW Ladies Auxiliary, Catholic Charities Foster Grandparent Program, Friends of the Library of New York Mills and founding member of the Rainbow Widows Group. June actively recruited for other volunteers to take part in these programs.

June was preceded in death by her husband Paul; parents; sister Ethel; brother-in-law Elroy; and step-grandson Andy Hansen.

She is survived by her children, Paul, Lori Alan, Joleen (Roger) Porter, Perry, Bonnie Kingsley, Angi (Lyle) Hansen, Patrick (Shona Kurzenberger), Cami (Neal) Apfelbeck, Becky (Larry) Shultz, 17 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren.

Memorials will be set up for the Christian Mothers Association and Heart of The Lakes Elementary.

Pallbearers will be Paul R. Stafki, Matthew Porter, Chad Shultz, Jacob Kingsley, Dominick Stafki and Luke Nolte.

Burial will be in St. John the Baptist Catholic Cemetery, Bluffton, MN.
