On November 30, 2024, Karen passed away with family by her side at Astera Health in Wadena, MN. She was 82 years old.

Karen Louise Reece was born to George D. and Noreen (Attleson) Reece on April 18, 1942, on the Reece family farm north of Wadena, MN. She attended District 11 country school until 6th grade and then Wadena Public Schools where she graduated with the class of 1960.

Karen married LaVern Erkenbrack on July 7, 1962, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Wadena. They moved to Texas the next day and returned to Minnesota in November 1963. From 1985 until her retirement, Karen worked in the strapping department at Homecrest Ind. In leisure hours she enjoyed

flower gardening, birdwatching and tracking family history. Mostly of all she treasured hours with her family, especially with her grandbabies and great grandbabies. She also devoted time to the Leaf River Cemetery Board.
