The Mass of Christian Burial for Karen Hopp of Staples, will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, February 8, at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Staples, with Father Gabriel Walz as celebrant. Karen, age 77, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, February 3, 2019, due to a fall at her home in Staples, MN.

Karen was born to Matthew Francis and Pearl Lorraine (Stave) Hoemberg on August 11, 1941, at Bertha, MN. Karen was united in marriage with Herbert Hopp on June 14, 1962, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Staples. 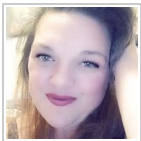
