The mass of Christian burial for Kelly Raymond Schertler of Moorhead and formerly of Wadena, will be held At 10:00 AM on Friday, October 25, 2013 at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena with Father Aaron Kuhn presiding. Friends may call at the church on Friday one hour prior to services. Kelly passed away at the age of 36 years on Saturday, October 19, 2013 at the Sanford Hospital in Fargo.

Kelly was born on June 13, 1977 at the Wadena Hospital in Wadena to Duane and Dot (Conn) Schertler. He graduated from Wadena-Deer Creek High School and then completed a two year program focusing on computers. He worked as a computer service tech for ASC Computer helping clients with their software problems. Computers were not only his job, but also his hobby. He also enjoyed playing guitar. He has lived and worked in the Moorhead area for 16 years.

Kelly was preceded in death by his infant daughter, Rainbow; and his grandparents. He is survived by his parents Duane and Dot; brothers Wayne (Kelly) of Savage, MN, Patrick (special friend Renee) of Virginia and Timothy of Georgia; sister Kimberly (special friend Eric) of Wadena; as well as his many friends.

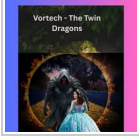
(Kelly wrote this poem for me as a gesture of our friendship)
