



Kenneth Greenwaldt

May 25, 1925 - January 26, 2006

Kenneth Marvin Greenwaldt, of Bartlett Township, passed away on Thursday, January 26, 2006 at the St. Cloud Hospital in St. Cloud, MN at the age of 80. Kenneth was born on a farm east of Bertha, MN to Alfred & Angie (Riley) Greenwaldt on May 25, 1925. He served in the US Army during World War II. He was united in marriage to Erma Snakenberg on June 15, 1947 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Hewitt, MN. They farmed in Staples Township until purchasing their homestead south of Aldrich, MN in the fall of 1959 and lived there until retirement in September of 1989, when they moved to their present home in rural Staples, MN. He is survived by Erma, his wife of 58 years; sons Wayne of Staples and Sid (Vicki) of Aldrich; daughters Jan (Tony) Jares, Nancy (Gary) Weber, both of Aldrich and Bonnie (Joel) Kassen of Goodhue, MN; 12 grandchildren: Jason, Travis & Nick (Carrie) Jares; Derek, Jesse & Erin Greenwaldt; Chris, Keri & KaLyn Weber; Kelly (Jason) Brown; and Justin & Ryan Kassen; and great grandson Dylan Jares. He is also survived by brothers and sisters Violet Larson, Florence Larson, Benjamin Greenwaldt, Irene Monaghan, Robert Greenwaldt, Vera Dickman, Gerald Greenwaldt and Phillip Greenwaldt. He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Alice Greenwaldt. Funeral services were held on Monday, January 30, 2006 at 1:00 PM at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Bartlett Township with Reverend William F. Moeller, Jr. presiding.
