



Kermit Jenson

April 8, 1934 - June 19, 2011

Wadena resident, Kermit Elliot Jenson was born to Kenneth and Edna (Sowers) Jenson on April 8, 1934 in Lyons Township, Wadena County, MN. Kermit was a member of the United States Army beginning in 1957, serving in Toul France near Nancy, until his honorable discharge in 1959. He continued to serve in the Army Reserve until 1963. Kermit and Margaret "Margie" Klause were united in marriage on June 22, 1960 at St. Hubert's Catholic Church in Bluegrass. Kermit worked as an AI Technician for 33 years. When time allowed he enjoyed gardening, woodworking, watching sports and visiting with family and friends. He will be remembered most for his humor, love of life, and his devotion to his family. Kermit died on June 19, 2011 at St. Cloud Hospital, at the age of 77 years. He was preceded in death by his parents Kenneth and Edna; brothers Dewey, Norman, and Wendell; and an infant sister. He is survived by his loving and devoted wife Margie of Wadena; son Bob of Minneapolis; daughters Bonnie (Curt) Rentz of Wadena, and Lori of Brooklyn Park; grandchildren Kari (Matt) Schmidt and Kyle Rentz; brother Myron (Marcella) of Pioneer, CA; sister Audrey (Ken) Boggs of Burlington, Ontario, Canada; and special family friends Mike Aronson and Lila Moe.
