October 14, 1980 - August 2, 2012

Memorial services for Lance Erik Mein, age 31 of Bertha were held at 2:00 PM on Monday, August 6, 2012, at the Domian-Anderson Chapel in Bertha. Lance passed away tragically in a truck accident Pine Lake Township, Cass County, Minnesota on August 2, 2012. Lance was born on October 14, 1980 at Windom, MN to Larry and Cindy (Schmicking) Mein. He graduated from high school and entered the US Air Force in August of 1999. He was united in marriage with Ashley White in March of 2004 at Cheyenne, WY. After his honorable discharge in August of 2005, he worked various jobs and in 2011 returned to school to obtain his CDL at Alexandria Technical College at Alexandria, MN. He has been working since graduation for Hunkes Transfer, Inc. in Wadena. Lance considered all of the Midwest his home, especially Minnesota. He enjoyed fishing and spending time with his children. Lance was preceded in death by his infant daughter Cathryan Ann; grandfather Lucas Mein and Walter Schmicking; and grandmother Alece Schmicking. He is survived by his wife Ashley; parents Larry and Cindy; son Christoffer of Bertha; daughters Cesilia, Sidney, Casandra (all of Bertha) and Angel Lee Stone of Oregon, IL; brother Loren (Hillari) Mein of Auburn, WA and sister Lauri (Doug) Nicholson of Acworth, GA. 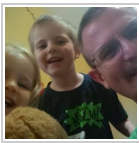
