



Larry Dixon

April 12, 1937 - August 7, 2015

The funeral service for Larry Dixon, of Wadena, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 13, at the Wadena Alliance Church in Wadena with Pastors Allen Refsland and Tom Werner presiding. Friends may call on Wednesday from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena, and at the church on Thursday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of service. Larry passed away on Friday, August 7, 2015, surrounded by his family. He was 78 years old.

Larry was born April 12, 1937, in Eagle City, OK. As a teenager, his family moved to California. In the early 1960s, he was a member of the National Guard and Army, serving stateside.

Larry was united in marriage with Norma Camacho, December 5, 1959, in Hillsburg, CA. By 1969, they moved their family to the Bertha - Hewitt area in Minnesota. Most of his career was in the logging and sawmill industries. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and was talented with mechanics and as a creative inventor. Larry became an ordained minister where his special traits of kindness, generosity, and a trusting nature could shine.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents Walter and Carrie; brothers Delbert and Dale Dixon; and sisters Ella Glendene Mauritsen and Barbara Miller.

He is survived by his loving wife Norma of Wadena; sons Jerry (Susan) Dixon and Dave (fiancee' Mhay Alea) Dixon of Wadena; daughters Lorene (Tim) Worwa of Blaine, Jean (Dale) Anderson of Lino Lakes and Melissa Dixon-Vanderpool of Plymouth; 16 grandchildren & 19 great-grandchildren; along with a host of friends.

Burial will be in the Moran Methodist Cemetery, Germainia Township, MN.
