Funeral services for Larry Luttrell age 60 of Wadena, were held at 4:00 PM on Monday, December 10, 2007, at the United Methodist Church in Wadena with Reverend Larry Hager presiding. Larry passed away at the University of Minnesota - Fairview Hospital in Minneapolis on December 6th. Larry Joe Luttrell was born on August 18, 1947 in El Reno, OK to Leland and Tyresa (Cox) Luttrell.
