



Larry Wegner

July 17, 1936 - May 24, 2007

Funeral services for Larry Wegner of Bertha were held at 1:00 PM on Monday, May 28, 2007 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bertha with Reverend Blake Rickbeil presiding. Larry passed away suddenly on Thursday, May 24, 2007 at the Lakewood Health Systems Hospital in Staples at the age of 70 years.

Larry Lee Wegner was born on July 17, 1936 at the home of his parents Walter and Gertrude (Matter) Wegner in Bertha Township. He graduated from Bertha High School. He served his country as a radio communications instructor in the US Army from 1959 until his honorable discharge in 1962. Larry was united in marriage with LaVonne Amanda Ehrens on January 5, 1963 at Detroit Lakes, MN. He worked as a railroad telegraph operator for the Northern Pacific Railroad, school bus driver for 28 years and farmer. He served his community as a member of the Bertha Township Board, a St. Paul's Lutheran Church elder and past president, the church choir, and kept books for the high school basketball teams for 20 years. Larry loved anything outdoors, including fishing and hunting, and was an avid spectator at all activities that involved his grandchildren. Larry was preceded in death by his father Walter; brothers Duane and James; sister Catherine; and nephew Matt Zweifel. He is survived by his wife LaVonne; mother Gertrude; son Scott of Bertha; daughters Shari (Bob) Moller of Enderlin, ND and Beth (Dave) Selvey of Bertha; grandchildren Austin, Brooke and Cole Selvey; brother Charles (Marilee) of Bertha; sisters JoAnne (Robert) Botterbusch of Spokane, WA, Wanda (Robert) Stapelberg of Rapid City, SD, Nancy (Charles) Aldrich of

Ottertail, MN and Judy (Jerry) Zweifel of Spokane. He is also survived by many wonderful nieces and nephews. Honorary pallbearers were Robert Stapelberg, Austin Selvey, Brooke Selvey and Cole Selvey.
