



Larry Woodworth

August 18, 1938 - September 22, 2008

Funeral services for Larry Woodworth of Clarissa, were held at 2:00 PM on Friday, September 26, 2008 at the Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran Church in Clarissa with Reverend Melissa Ehrhardt presiding. Larry passed away on Monday, September 22, 2008 at the Long Prairie Memorial Hospital in Long Prairie at the age of 70 years. Larry Dwain Woodworth was born on August 18, 1938 at Venus, Nebraska to Irvin George and Shirley Mae (Strope) Woodworth. After graduating from high school, he entered the US Army. He honorably served his country from December 13, 1957 until December 31, 1977, being discharged with the rank of NCO E-7 Sergeant First Class. While in service, he was united in marriage with Carmen Navarro Lefarga on July 25, 1961 at Orleans, France. Following his discharge, Larry moved his family to Clarissa and worked as a mechanic for Hess Equipment in Eagle Bend. He enjoyed fishing and camping. Larry was preceded in death by his parents Irvin and Shirley Woodworth; infant sister Phyllis; and nieces Pamela Woodworth, Sheila Sudbeck and Taaylor Miller. He is survived by wife Carmen; daughter Maria (Greg) Pooler of Eagle Bend; 2 granddaughters and 6 great-grandchildren; brothers Phil (Linda) of Ft. Worth, TX, Denny (Christina) of Glenallen, MO, and Irvin Jr. (LaRae) of Parkers Prairie; and sisters Carolyn Miller and Linda (Bob) Sudbeck, both of Eagle Bend.
