



## Leona Holum

May 31, 1924 - September 13, 2011

Memorial services for Leona Mae Holum of Eagle Bend were held at 11:00 AM on Friday, September 16, 2011 at the Faith Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Pastor Hollis Bishop presiding. Leona passed away at the age of 87 years on Tuesday, September 13, 2011 at her home in Wykeham Township. Leona was born on May 31, 1924 to Tilford and Helen (Olson) Thompson at their home in Burleene Township. She was united in marriage with Glen Reidar Holum on June 15, 1946 at Minneapolis, MN. She worked as a psychiatric technician at the Brainerd State Hospital and as a beautician prior to that. Leona and Glen moved to their home in rural Eagle Bend in 1987. Leona was preceded in death by her husband Glen on September 17, 1999; parents Tilford and Helen Thompson; brother Donovan Thompson; and sisters Georgine Adelle Hampton and Opal Burnyeat. She is survived by her children Philip of Eagle Bend and Linda Brede of Kandiyohi, MN; 5 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren; brothers Lynden Thompson of South Haven, MN and Ron Thompson of Hutchinson, MN; and sister Norma Bullock of Ramsey, MN.
