Memorial services for Lester Jasmer of Wadena are scheduled for Thursday, October 5, 2006 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Bartlett Township, Todd County. Lester passed away at the VA Medical Center in Minneapolis on Sunday, October 1, 2006. He was 70 years old. Lester Wilbur Jasmer was born on May 15, 1936 to Rudolph William and Clara Emma(Lehmann) Jasmer at their home in rural Verndale, MN. He entered Air Force Basic Training at Loveland AFB in San Antonio, TX in 1956. He was stationed at Forbes AFB in Topeka, KS from January, 1954 until October, 1957. He was in charge of base flight at Forbes Field. Lester married Virginia Rae Wagor on June 7, 1957. After leaving the service, he worked for Goodyear Tire & Rubber and later worked for farmers repairing tractors and other equipment. He has lived in the Wadena and Verndale area for over 18 years. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, cooking and spending valuable time with his children and grandchildren. Lester was preceded in death by his parents; and brothers Ben, Lawrence, Fred and Marvin.
