Linda Esther Horst was born on November 24, 1926 to her parents Fredrick and Anna (Thielmann) Horst in Alvord, IA. She passed away on February 9, 2010, at the age of 83, at Tri-County Hospital in Wadena, MN. In the late 1930s and early 1940s Linda was a seamstress for Wadena County.
