She graduated from Wadena Senior High School in 1931 and from the Minneapolis Business College in 1932. Lola worked as a Clerk of Probate Court under Elmer Larson. After her marriage to Victor Olson at her parents home in Wadena on June 1, 1935 they moved to a farm in Leaf River Township until retiring from farming on account of Victor's health in 1980.
