October 18, 1942 - March 28, 2009

Funeral services for Loren Hansen of Hewitt, formerly of Owatonna and Faribault, were held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, April 2, 2009 at the Church of the Nazarene in Hewitt with Reverend Johannes Marsland presiding. Loren Passed away at the age of 66 years on Saturday, March 28, 2009, at his home in Hewitt. Loren Neil Hansen was born on October 18, 1942 to Wallace and Gladys (Dahl) Hansen at Blooming Prairie, MN. He married LaDonna (Wilcox) Grunwald on July 3, 1978 at Mitchell, SD. He worked construction around the area for many years and also farmed.
