Lorraine, age 93, passed away on Saturday, July 13, 2019 at Fair Oaks Lodge, Wadena, MN.

Lorraine was born to Martin and Anna (Langer) DuMont on November 17, 1925, in Wadena, MN. After high school, she attended business school and worked at General Mills in Minneapolis.

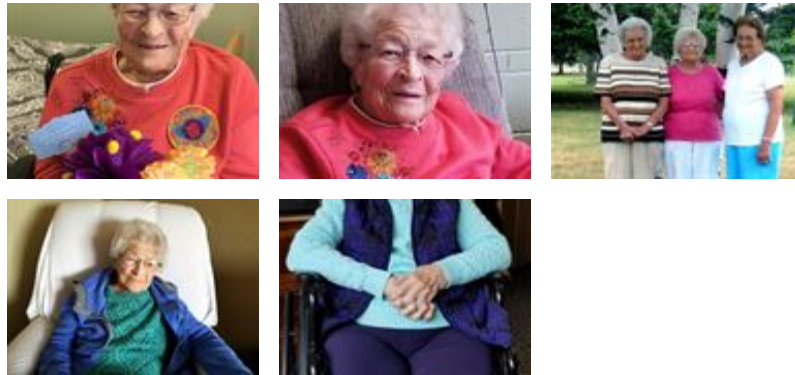
