Lorraine passed away on August 10, 2021 at her home in Redwood City, CA.

Lorraine Lois Wallgren was born June 14, 1930 at home In Blowers Township, rural Sebeka, MN, Her parents were Edwin and Ethel (Ehnert) Wallgren. Growing up, Lorraine attended country school at District 220, and graduated from Sebeka High School in 1948. After completing Normal Teachers Training, she taught at District 169 for three years.

On September 7, 1952, she married Edward "Eddie" Kallerman at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Sebeka. Together they farmed the Kallerman family farm for three years, later farming near Butler for several more years. After moving to Wadena, Lorraine was a teachers aide for 14 years at the Wadena Public School.

In their retirement, Lorraine and Eddie wintered for many years in McAllen, TX. By 2006, they moved to Redwood City, CA, to be near their children, Lorraine greatly enjoyed gardening, camping and fishing. She will always be

remembered by her grandchildren as a grandma who had time to play and also prayed for them.

Lorraine is survived by a daughter, Patricia (Mark) Van Nuys; son Alan (Therese) Kallerman; 8 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her husband Eddie; son Larry; grandson Ezra; parents Edwin and Ethel Wallgren; brother Orville; and sister Betty May.
