



## Lorraine Lind

December 5, 1922 - May 15, 2012

Funeral services for G. Lorraine "Larry" Lind of Eagle Bend, were held at 11:00 AM on Friday, May 18, 2012 at the New Life Church of God in Bertha with Pastor Mark Brown presiding. Lorraine passed away peacefully at the age of 89 years on Tuesday, May 15, 2012 at her home in Eagle Bend surrounded by family and friends. Gwendolyn Lorraine was born on December 5, 1922 at Thief River Falls, MN to E.O. and Hannah (Sanden) Greene. She served her country as a member of the US Navy Waves during and following WWII. She was united in marriage with her beloved husband Kenneth Harry Lind at Salt Lake City, UT on December 28, 1949. Larry worked in business bookkeeping and secretarial employment in the Twin Cities, Billings, MT as well as Wadena, Bertha and Eagle Bend. She and Kenneth also operated a farm southeast of Bertha for over 30 years. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Todd County Farm Bureau, the 7th Congressional District Republican Party and various other community organizations throughout the years. Lorraine was preceded in death by her husband Kenny on February 15, 1999; parents E.O. and Hannah Greene; brothers Kenwood and Harris Greene; and sisters Eleanor Trites, Muriel Taurinkas, Donna Rosell and Doris Greene.
