February 4, 1939 - January 23, 2010

Funeral services for Lorraine Martha Westergren of Royalton, and formerly of Deerwood and Bertha, were held at 11:00 AM on Friday, January 29, 2010 at the New Life Church of God in Bertha with Pastor Mark Brown and Pastor Mike Palkie presiding. Lorraine went to heaven on Saturday, January 23rd 2010 at 6:00 PM in her home at Royalton surrounded by her family after a courageous battle with cancer. She was 70 years of age. Lorraine was born on February 4th 1939 to Herman and Evelyn Priebe in Russell, MN. Lorraine went to High School in Bertha and Nursing school in St. Paul. She married Wayne William Westergren on February 13th 1960 in Eagle Bend. She resided in Bertha for many years, in Deerwood for 14 years and Royalton for 7 months.
