



Louise Hulting

July 8, 1919 - May 28, 2010

Rachel Louise Hayes Hulting, 90, died on May 28, 2010, at Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN. A celebration of her life was held on Thursday, June 3, at First Congregational United Church of Christ, Wadena. Burial was at the Wadena Cemetery. Louise was born on July 8, 1919, to George Ferris and Bernice (Jones) Hayes in Elgin, Wabasha County, MN. She graduated from Galva High School and attended Iowa State University. In Galva, she married Carl F. Hulting, of Geneseo, IL. Louise was known as the “pie lady”, baking a fruit pie for anyone or any occasion that needed one. She was a member of the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Wadena, and a faithful and integral part of the Women’s Fellowship. She served on the County Welfare Board, and worked in the City Library, along with other jobs and organizations. She, and friends, took on the project of planting and watering several city gardens for many years. Louise was preceded in death by her husband, Carl F. Hulting, in October 1992; her son Robert Bruce Hulting; a brother; and two sisters. Louise is survived by Jane (Jim Cohen) Hulting of Elkins Park, Pennsylvania, Ann (Dicksan Tashjian) Hulting of Berkley, CA; grandchildren Robert (Laura) Tashjian of Belmont, CA, Hannah (Jason) Warriner of Oakland, CA, and Jonathan Hulting-Cohen a student at the University of Michigan; much beloved great-granddaughters Ella and Nina Tashjian; sister, Jeannette Hayes Sherman, of Las Vegas, NV; brother-in-laws Alvin Hulting of Annawan, IL, and Mauritz Hulting of Geneseo, IL; and cousin Margaret Anderson of Oneida.
