Louise peacefully passed away surrounded by family on May 18, 2024, at the age of 91 years, in Wadena, MN.

Nancy Louise Daniels was born to Harold and Rachel (Spencer) Daniels on October 28, 1932, in Fairfield, NC. She was known to all as Louise, Lou or Weezy and grew up in the Great Bridge area of Virginia. It is here that she met the love of her life Lawrence Vandenberghe who was serving in the Navy and

was stationed at a base only a few miles away from her home. They were married at the Catholic Church in Chesapeake, VA in 1955 and resided in a home built by Lawrence and Harold on the same lot as her childhood home. In 1961, they moved to Minnesota, eventually buying farmland and building a dairy farm. In 1978, they sold the farm, and she began a 24-year career at the Wadena Deer Creek Schools in the food service department.

Louise loved to cook, bake, sew, craft, quilt, and play games of all types, and excelled at cribbage and pinochle. She was active in her homemaker club and played many roles in her children's 4H club. She was also involved with the Sebeka American Legion and Auxiliary.

Preceding Louise in death were her husband Lawrence; infant son, Joseph, and son, Keith; brothers, Dayton and Lloyd; and sisters, Betty Lou, Naomi and Sybil.

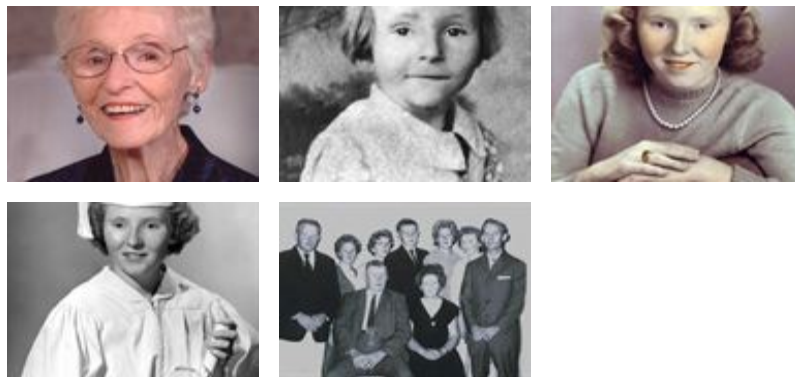
