September 3, 1916 - February 17, 2010

The Mass of Christian Burial for Louise Christine Wagner was held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, February 20, 2010 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Bertha with Father Dan Walz presiding. Louise passed away at the age of 93 years on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 at the Lakewood Health System's Care Center in Staples. Louise was born on September 3, 1916 to Louis and Mary (Hastreiter) Blashack at the home in Woodside Township, rural Parkers Prairie. She graduated from Parkers Prairie High School and from Miller Vocational Graduate Department of Nursing. She was united in marriage with Morton L.
