Funeral services for Margaret Packard, a resident of the Central Todd County Care Center in Clarissa and formerly of Bertha, will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday at the Wrightstown United Methodist Church at Wrightstown with Pastor J.C. Margaret passed away at the Care Center in Clarissa on Saturday, April 12, 2014.

Margaret was born to William and Nellie (Perkins) Bryce on November 15, 1915, in Woodside Township, Otter Tail County, MN. On July 15, 1945, Margaret was united in marriage with Frank Walter Packard at the United Methodist Church in Wrightstown.
