Margie attended and graduated from Verndale High School. She worked at the movie theatre where she met her true love Harold Goepferd. They were married August 19, 1943. In 1947, they moved to Bertha where they raised their three children. Margie had a variety of jobs. Her latest was selling Avon. She sold Stanley Home products, waitressed at the River Inn, and worked with Harold operating the Laundromat. She was a life long active member of the American Legion Auxiliary and was Department President in 1974. As an active member of The United Church of Christ, she sang for many funerals and other events. She did volunteer calling for church and other organizations. Margie enjoyed sports: especially the MN Twins and Vikings. She also loved to play cards and read. Family and friends enjoyed many hand knit and crocheted items that Marge created.
