Marie passed away at the age of 89, at Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN, surrounded by her family.

Marie was born to Joseph and Susan (Loesch) Neis, September 14, 1926, in Rockville, MN, and attended Kimball country school. She grew up on a farm in Kimball, MN with her sisters and brothers. There she developed a great love for horses, including bare-back racing. This was the beginning of a lifetime of managing and working her own farm, where her cattle became the highest grade. Her love of animals was always evident. She enjoyed dairy farming and was actively involved in that profession until the age of 75. A highlight and honor for Marie was being selected Farmer of the Month, and stated "farming is a way of life that can't be beat". She loved the country life and her many pets!

Marie was united in marriage with Ambrose Kramer on May 14, 1946, in Rockville, MN. To this union eight children were added.

Marie was preceded in death by her parents Joseph and Susan; husband Ambrose; infant son Joseph, and son David; brothers Sylvester, Melvin, Donald, Albin and Andrew; and sisters Rosemary and Edvina.

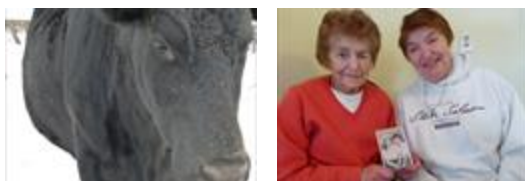

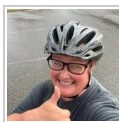
