Marvin William Pundt passed away on Sunday, Dec. 18th at the Tri-County Hospital in Wadena. He was born to William & Ella (Meinhardt) Pundt Dec. 22, 1922 in Bartlett Township. He grew up on the family farm and attended school through the 8th grade. He then hired out to neighbors putting up hay and doing field work. In Sept. of 1944 he married Evelyn Smith and a short time later was drafted into the Army, serving in the Philippines and Korea. He was very proud of his service to his country. After his discharge in 1946, he started farming and going to carpenter school in the evenings. He farmed until 1959 and then moved to Wadena to do carpenter work full time. He retired in 1988. Together he and Evelyn enjoyed traveling and camping in their motor home, and spending time with their three sons and families. He was a great husband, father, grand father and friend to all that knew him. Marvin was preceded in death by his parents; grandson Jamie Pundt; two brothers and two sisters. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Evelyn; sons Jim (Karen) of Dickinson, ND, Jerry (Mary) of Maple Grove and Roger (Sue) of Lindstrom; 5 grandchildren; sister Melda (George) Eide of El Dorado Hills, CA. Burial will take place in the Wadena Cemetery following the services.
