A private graveside service honoring the life of Mary Ann Ehnes, of Eagle Bend, will be held at the Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery, Little Falls, MN.

Mary Ann, age 88, passed away on August 12, 2024, at Long Prairie Health Care Center with gentle care by Moments Hospice.

Mary Ann was born to Henry and Florence (Kramvik) Hagelstrom on April 2, 1936, in Bryant, SD. She attended Daniel's Country School and graduated from Bertha-Hewitt School in 1954. Her favorite subjects were shorthand and chorus along with Library Service Club.
