MaryAnn, age 76, passed away with family by her side on Thursday, March 19, 2020, at the Perham Living Care Center in Perham, MN.

MaryAnn was born to Mathias and Eleanor (Buettner) Weniger on January 2, 1944, in Breckenridge, MN. She was raised on a farm west of Wahpeton, ND. After completing the first grade at a country school, her family moved to Wadena, MN. She attended St. Ann's Parochial School and then graduated from Wadena Public Schools in 1962. After graduation, she was employed full-time at Wadena Federal Savings & Loan and was later appointed Assistant Secretary-Treasurer.

MaryAnn was united in marriage with Ralph Haman on June 6, 1966, at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Wadena. They were blessed with six children. MaryAnn became a stay-at-home mom, helping out at the Savings & Loan as needed. In later years, she was employed by the Schuett Company of Golden Valley as manager of the Kaleva Apartments in New York Mills for over 16 years, before retiring in June of 2005. MaryAnn was a member of St. John's Catholic Church and Christian Mothers in Bluffton. She enjoyed gardening, feeding birds, puzzles and counted cross-stitch. She especially valued the time spent with her grandchildren whom she dearly loved.

Preceding MaryAnn in death were her parents Mathias and Eleanor; and infant grandchildren Angela, Adam and Amanda.

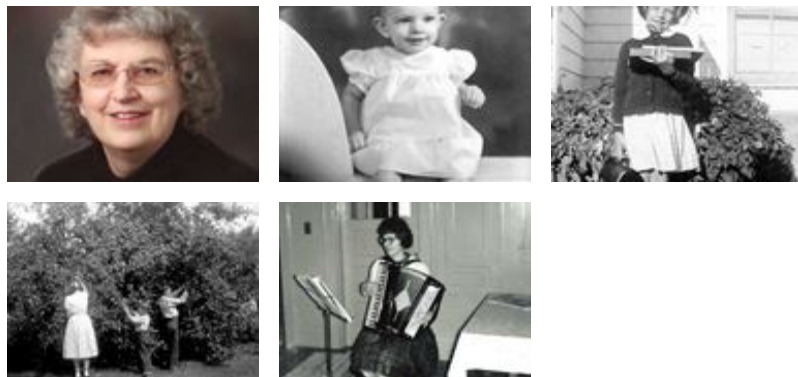
