June 29, 1955 - July 5, 2023

Services celebrating the life of Michael Lindeman of Ottertail will be held privately.

Surrounded by his family, Michael, age 68, passed away on July 5, 2023 at his home in Ottertail, MN, with compassionate care by Knute Nelson Hospice.

Michael was born to Lawrence and Jeanette (Loberg) Lindeman in Minneapolis, MN on June 29, 1955. He received education at Lake Park, Cushing, Pillager and Bertha-Hewitt. As a child, Mike loved to fish. He fished for hours and caught fish for his mother to fry.

Mike was united in marriage with Vicky Lynn Klemek on June 30, 1990, in Hewitt, MN. He worked in tar-roofing back in the day, and even tar-roofed Tuffy's in Perham. That job took him to many different cities and states. He worked longest at the body shop in Bertha where he loved his job and being his own boss. He was a body shop and sandblaster for 30 years. By 2003, Mike and Vicky sold their home and his body shop to move to West Yellowstone, MT, and bought an apartment complex. In their seven years in Montana, Mike did a lot of snowmobiling, and hunting. He dropped four elk during that time They sold the apartment complex and moved to Ottertail, MN in June 2010. Mike was hired at Barrel O' Fun in nearby Perham in 2011 and in 2019, he worked at Kenny's Candy until the end of May 2023.

Leisure hours found Mike fishing, hunting and talking about fishing and hunting! He enjoyed riding motorcycle and often lent a hand to anyone needing help. His special trait was being able to fix “dang near anything”! A regular handyman, he was.

Preceding Michael in death were his dad, Lawrence; and brother, Russell “Rusty” Lindeman.

Mike is survived by his wife, Vicky; son, Chad (Tonia) Lindeman of Bismarck, ND; grandchildren, Madison, Kaia, Gavin and Kambrin; mother Jeanette Loberg of Woodbury; siblings: Carole (Jerry) Zimmerman of Bertha, Wayne (Ida) Lindeman of Newark, CA and Teresa (Joe) Yasis of Lakeland; nieces: Jackie, Christi and Megan; nephews: Jason, Andrew, Chad, Aaron and Josh.

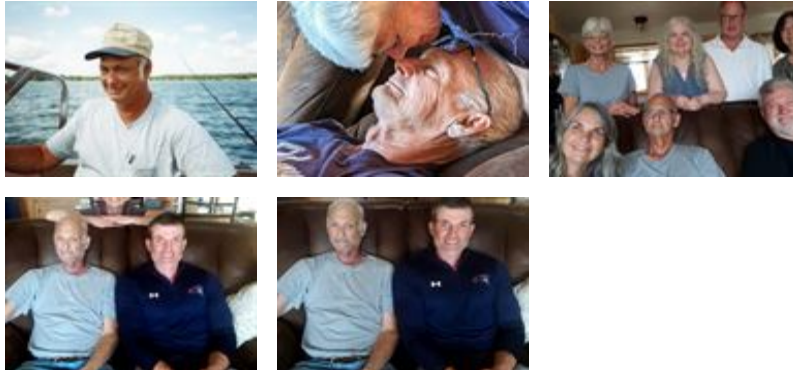
