



Mildred Fyten

August 28, 1910 - September 12, 2014

The funeral service for Mildred Elizabeth Fyten of Wadena will be held 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 23, 2014, at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena, with Pastor Robert Forbes officiating. Visitation will be held at the funeral home on Tuesday from 12:30p.m. until the time of service. At the age of 104, Mildred passed away on September 12, 2014, at Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN.

Mildred was born August 28, 1910, to Millard and Hattie Bloom in Loretto, NE. In her late teens, the family moved to Hubbard, MN, and later to Sebeka. In 1928, Mildred graduated from high school at Maplewood Academy, Maple Plain. That fall she started nurses training at the Boulder Sanatorium and Hospital in Boulder, CO, graduating on her birthday in 1932. She returned to Minnesota where she received her degree as a Registered Nurse. She did private duty nursing for a short time, and then was offered the position of Night Supervisor at Wesley Hospital in Wadena. She accepted, and remained there for the following ten years. Mildred moved to Minneapolis and was employed at the following hospitals: Eitel, Veterans and Swedish. On September 18, 1956, she was united in marriage with Edward T. Fyten, of St. Paul, who was a Greyhound bus driver. In 1960, they moved to Wadena, so Mildred would be near her father, since her mother had passed away in 1946. Once more she worked at Wesley Hospital, part-time until 1973, when her father passed away. Mildred and Ed enjoyed fishing in area lakes, in northern Minnesota and

Canada.

Mildred was preceded in death by her husband Edward; parents Millard and Hattie; brother Lawrence; niece Betty Barker; along with her adopted brothers Leslie & Earl Pearson.

She is survived by great-nephews Thomas (Kathy) Barker of Alexandria, and Brad (Kathy) Barker of Walker.

Pallbearers will be Tom Barker, Brad Barker, Kerry Barker, Mike Barker, Mark Hockert, Mark Schwantz, Leland Trana and Duane Trana.

Burial will be in the Wadena Cemetery, Wadena, MN.
