OBITUARY Palmer Louis Brueske was born on June 29, 1924 at home in Ida Township in Douglas county to Henry and Josephine (Kloehn) Brueske. Palmer served his country in the Army during World War II from 1944 to 1946, assigned to Company C, 27th Infantry in the Asiatic Pacific theater. During his service, he and Leona Barbara Abel were united in marriage at Leaf Valley, MN. Following his honorable discharge, he returned to his bride and the family farm. Palmer was a farmer his whole life. He has lived in Bertha for 40 years and was active in his church as a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church Board of Elders and his community as member of the Bertha Township Board and the American Legion. He enjoyed watching TV, traveling, fishing and most of all he loved spending time with his family. Palmer passed away Wednesday morning at the St. Cloud Hospital after a lengthy illness at the age of 78. Palmer was preceded in death by his parents Henry and Josephine Brueske; 2 stillborn sons; brothers Lawrence Brueske and Arthur Brueske; and his sister Jeanette Schaefer.
