Paul Willard Evans was born on December 27, 1942, to Willard and Abigail (Kittleson) Evans in Appleton, MN. Paul and Janet “Jan” DeBoer were united in marriage on September 1, 1962 in Crookston. It was then that Paul began working for Red Owl in Bloomington, until 1966, when he started working for Mason Brothers Wholesale in Wadena. He retired in 1985, and he and Jan moved to Ottertail Lake, later moving to the Northwest Angle in 1993. Most of all he loved his family and enjoyed guiding them and his friends on Lake of the Woods for walleye, often taking a dollar from them on a “1st fish” bet! He also enjoyed hunting and playing cribbage. Paul passed away, unexpectedly, on October 17, 2010, at the age of 67, at home in Angle Inlet. Paul was preceded in death by his parents; and his sister Kathryn. He is survived by his loving wife Jan of Angle Inlet; daughters Lori (Ken) Kneisl of Wadena, and Lisa (John) Stainbrook of Burnsville; son David (Darnell) of Omaha, NE; 7 grandchildren & 1 great-grandchild; and sisters Margaret (Jim) Dix of Gig Harbor, WA, and Mary (Henry) Brei of Roseburg, OR. Memorial services were held at 2:00 p.m. on October 22, 2010, at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Wadena, with Pastor Bob Griggs officiating.
