December 23, 1907 - March 11, 2008

Paul E. Lundell, age 100, a resident of Fair Oaks Lodge, Wadena, passed away on March 11, 2008 at Tri-County Hospital in Wadena. He was born to Anna and Olaf Lundell on December 23, 1907 in Bellingham, WA. Paul was united in marriage to Alice E. Oien on June 15, 1935 in Thief River Falls. Paul and Toddy were members of the Wadena community for 69 years and he will be remembered as an owner and baker at Banquet Bakery. He was involved in the Wadena Lions Club and enjoyed golf and spectator sports, especially Twins baseball. Paul was preceded in death by his wife in 2004; parents; and brother Wendell. He is survived by son Paul (Margie) of Fargo, ND; daughter Joyce Crozier of St. Paul; 5 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren; brother Irving (Arlene) of Sun City West, AZ; sisters-in-law Harriet Starkey of Duluth, Marian Gilbertson of Halstad; brothers-in-law Gordy (Lois) Oien of Red Wing, Gus (Arlene) Oien of Fargo, ND, and many nieces and nephews.
