Friendly, kind-hearted, and always smiling, Paul Mahlon Wheeler was born on June 22, 1938 at Wesley Hospital, in Wadena, MN. He grew up in Henning, MN. He graduated from Henning High School in 1956. He enlisted in the Air Force from 1956-1960 when he was honorably discharged. From 1961-1984, he worked for Western Electric, which later became AT&T doing phone service networking. He married Dianne (Seeman) Wheeler in 1963 and together they had two children, Jon Wheeler and Brenda (Wheeler) Finch. After working for AT&T, he worked for Oakridge Homes in Wadena, from 1991-2001, when he finally retired.
