



Pearl Hoemberg

November 5, 1921 - November 6, 2016

The Mass of Christian Burial for Pearl Hoemberg, age 95, a resident of Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN, and formerly of Staples, will be celebrated at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 12, 2016 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Staples, MN, with Father Joe Korf as celebrant. Visitation will be held on Friday at the Johnson-Schuller Chapel in Wadena from 6:00 until 8:00 p.m. with a rosary at 6:00 and prayers at 7:00 p.m. Visitation will resume at the church on Saturday from 9:30 a.m. until the time of Mass. One day after celebrating her 95th birthday, on November 6, 2016, Pearl passed away at the Fair Oaks Lodge, Wadena, MN.

Pearl was born to Roy and Clara (Olson) Stave on November 5, 1921, in Moran Township, Todd County, MN. She attended country school through the eighth grade. Pearl was united in marriage with Matthew Francis Hoemberg on February 20, 1941 at the Rectory of Sacred Heart Church in Staples. They made their home on a farm west of there where her hours were filled with caring for her large family. Pearl quilted, gardened, and canned, and was especially fond of cooking and baking for her family and friends. She collected cups and saucers and dolls. Pearl was an avid Bingo player and loved to play cards! She was a member of Catholic Foresters and the mission circle at church.

Pearl was preceded in death by her husband Matthew on August 16, 2003; parents Roy and Clara; sons Lawrence "Larry" and infant John Leo Hoemberg; and infant twin daughters Janice and Janet; brothers Russell, Gerald and Royce; sisters Opal Mertens, Ruby May and Carol Canfield; sons-in-law Herb Hopp and John Putz; and daughters-in-law Charlette and Sharron Hoemberg.
