The funeral service for Pearl Krause, of Eagle Bend, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, December 20, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend with Pastor Justin Hesterman officiating. Friends may call at the church on Friday from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m., and again on Saturday from 12:30 p.m. until the time of service. Pearl was called to her heavenly home on December 16, 2014, at the Central Todd County Care Center in Clarissa.

Pearl was born on February 18, 1923, in Leslie Township near Osakis, MN. She was baptized on May 13, 1923, at Trinity Lutheran Church, in Long Prairie, MN. She graduated from Clarissa High School and Minneapolis Business College. She was united in marriage to Harold Krause on June 22, 1946 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Eagle Bend, MN. They made their home on the family farm west of Eagle Bend. Pearl was a loving wife and mother to her six children. She enjoyed traveling with Harold, spending winters in Mission, TX, reading, journaling, quilting, playing cards, and tending her many flower gardens. Pearl enjoyed a good laugh.
