



Pearl Miller

March 21, 1914 - October 13, 2015

The graveside service for Pearl Miller of Deer Creek, will be held at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, October 17th, 2015, at Oak Valley Cemetery in rural Hewitt, MN. A memorial service is being planned with family members at a later date. At the age of 101, Pearl died at her home in Deer Creek, MN on Tuesday, October 13, 2015.

Pearl Marie Miller was born to William and Louise (Leidig) Althouse on March 21, 1914 in Alvo, NE where she also attended school. On October 22, 1932, Pearl married George C. Miller at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Eagle, NE. The couple resided in rural southeast Nebraska before moving to Trinidad and Canon City, CO. After returning to Nebraska with their growing family, the couple moved to rural Deer Creek, MN in 1955. George died in 1981 and Pearl resided at their home in rural Deer Creek until her death.

Pearl spent many years milking cows, tending her garden, canning fruits and vegetables, making the best bread, rolls, banana bread and strawberry preserves anywhere. She was a loving mother and grandmother to her large family and enjoyed her long, healthy life.

Pearl was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Deer Creek, and was involved with a neighborhood club and senior center activities.

Pearl was preceded in death by her parents William and Louise Althouse; husband George; sons George "Dickey", Charles, David and Leroy; daughter Cathie Harre, sons-in-law Gordon Johnson, and Jerome Harre; daughter-in-law Donna (David) Miller; brothers Clarence, Ivan, Lloyd and William Althouse; sisters Alma Umland, Caroline Simmons, Letha Cobb and Vesta "Becky" Macauley.

She is survived by sons Harold (Linda) of Pearland, TX, James and Karl, both of Deer Creek, MN, John of Porter, TX; daughters Pauline Johnson of Waco, NE, Linda Weber of Zumbrota, MN and Marilyn Miller of Loveland, CO; 19 grandchildren, 39 great-grandchildren and several great-great grandchildren.
