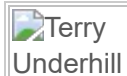

I used to giggle when Ray would tease her, He told me once they practiced birth control by Sharon standing on a bucket while they made love, then when the time came he'd kick the bucket. Sharon would get so red and flustered, and he'd just duck the slap coming his way, laugh and run. They were awesome. When I was away at basic training, my mother and my daughter (at that time she was carrying my first grandson) were at odds, the situation was too dangerous for my daughter to stay at my home. I was about to pull out of basic training and go home, I had called Sharon told her that I was coming home and would need to be picked up in Fresno. Sharon said why, what's going on, I told her, she said hang on she and Ray talked and asked if they took my daughter in could I complete my training, said didn't know, Well the Jag said I could if they became temp guardians over my daughter.
