



## Reverend Ronald Hume

June 14, 1933 - December 18, 2015

The memorial service for Ronald Hume of Wadena will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 16, 2016, at the United Methodist Church in Hubbard, MN. Visitation will be held at the church on Saturday one hour prior to the service. With family by his side, Ron passed away at the age of 82, on Friday, December 18, 2015, at the Fair Oaks Lodge in Wadena, MN.

Ronald was born to Joseph and Mildred (King) Hume on June 14, 1933, in Wichita, KS. Ron was united in marriage with Vida Mae Wagar on June 3, 1957, in Denver, CO. He continued his education and achieved his Masters of Divinity.
