



Robert Missling

September 13, 1950 - December 26, 2014

The funeral service for Robert “Bob” Missling, age 64, of rural Wadena, will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, January 2, 2015, at the Verndale Alliance Church with Pastor Daryl Jacobson officiating. Friends may call on Thursday, January 1, from 5:00 to 8:00p.m. at the Domian-Anderson Chapel in Bertha. Visitation will resume on Friday at the Alliance Church in Verndale from 9:30a.m. until the time of service. At the age of 64, Bob passed away on Friday, December 26, 2014 at his home.

Robert was born to Raymond E and Mavis W. (Polzin) Missling on September 13, 1950, at the Thiel Hospital in Bertha, MN. He was raised on the Missling farm near Hewitt, attended Hewitt Elementary and graduated from Bertha-Hewitt High School in 1968. While in high school Bob played basketball and was a member of the band playing trumpet. Upon graduation, Bob moved to the Twin Cities to work at Hitchcock Industries. After a few years he returned to the area to farm near Deer Creek. While also assisting his parents, Bob eventually moved to his parent's farm and began taking technical courses for plumbing in Wadena. Upon completion, Bob began working heavy equipment with Duane Moench, also building water treatment plants throughout the region, and eventually worked for Braaten Aggregate. On November 30, 1990, Bob married Constance G. Messer at the Todd County Courthouse in Long Prairie. In 1991, Bob finished building a house that he custom detailed, the

house that he and Connie called home.

Bob had an ear for music and was a self-taught guitar player. Before his injury, he often played in a band with his brother Vernelle, Dale "Red" Lovelace and Marlo Marsh. Bob was also keenly interested in geology and collected unique rocks, specifically agates. He also liked to hunt and ice fish. Bob firmly enjoyed watching and following professional sports from football to basketball, particularly the Minnesota Vikings.

Preceding Bob in death were his parents Ray and Mavis Missling; and niece Dena Missling.

He is survived by his wife Connie of Wadena; children Bryan (Jennifer) Suchy of Excelsior, and Kimberly (Mark) Marshall of St Cloud; grandchildren Stella, Henry and George Suchy and Quinlen, Adam and Holly Marshall; brother Vernelle (Linda) Missling of Menasha; sisters Janice (Marvin) Larson of New Prague, and Karen (Ron) Grewe of Bertha; along with several nieces and nephews.
