June 11, 1916 - December 19, 2012

The funeral service for Roy Line of Verndale will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 22, 2012 at the Christian & Missionary Alliance Church in Verndale, with Pastor Daryl Jacobson presiding. Friends may call at the church on Saturday one hour prior to the service. Roy passed away on Wednesday, December 19, 2012, at the age of 96, at the Central Todd County Care Center in Clarissa, MN.

Roy Arnold Line was born on June 11, 1916, to Alfred Jacob and Gerda Marie (Grandlund) Line in Clarissa Village, MN. Roy and Evelyn Marie Line were united on March 13, 1972 in Aitkin. He served honorably in the U.S. Army during WW II. He found his livelihood working with heavy equipment. In 1976, he retired from business and moved from Colorado to Minnesota where Weiher Construction built their home.

Roy was preceded in death by his wife in March 2008; his parents Alfred and Gerda; brother Joyce Line; sister Thelma Meadow; and sisters-in-law Irene Line and Betty Line, and brothers-in-law Vernon Anderson and Joseph Allen.

He is survived by his daughter Peggy (Mike) Abbitichio of NY and a step-daughter Audrey (Roger) Moede of Grand Rapids; five grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren; brothers Stanley, Allyn sisters Sylvia Anderson, Beatrice Allen and Glenda (John) McDonald; sister-in-law Velma Line; and

many nieces and nephews.

Honorary pallbearers will be all of Roy's nieces and nephews. Serving as pallbearers will be Kermit Line, Donald Line, Dwight Line, Jerry Line, Stuart Anderson and Jimmy Anderson. Military honors will be provided by the Elmer Goche Post 3922, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Wadena, MN.
