Roy Ralph Wendorf was born on May 3, 1928, to Herman and Emma (Volgmann) Wendorf on the family farm in Otter Tail County, MN. He passed away on December 13, 2010, at the age of 82, at Douglas County Hospital in Alexandria.

Roy served honorably in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. On March 28, 1953, he was united in marriage with Marlys Wilma Graven at Trinity Lutheran Church in Deer Creek. He lived his entire life in the Deer Creek area where he provided for his family and community as a contractor, carpenter, and farmer. He was a member of the Lions Club, Rod & Gun Club, American Legion, and Deer Creek School Board. He gave his time to the Trinity Lutheran Church Council & served as a sexton. His interests were in baseball, playing cards, farming, and hunting.
