Ruth Constance Erickson was born to Albert and Laura (Thorsen) Erickson on November 25, 1931, in Wadena, MN. She was united in marriage with John Baker on July 26, 1948, in Wadena. He passed away on April 17, 1975. Ruth raised her children while caring for her aunt and mother until they passed. She then decided to work out of the home. She worked at the Red Owl Bakery in Wadena and Nasch Finch in Corcoran, and then as a home health aide for

several years. Ruth enjoyed reading her Bible along with cooking for her family and friends. At St. John Lutheran Church in Wadena she belonged to LWML and the Guild. She loved traveling, water aerobics, sewing, walking, riding her bike and dancing, not to mention watching westerns and listening to country music.

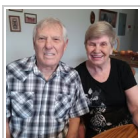
